GUIDELINES:

- Driver’s licenses and/or vehicle registrations will be checked for verification of Warren County residency. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- Only 10 tires per residency will be accepted. (Multiple trips will not be allowed)
- Tires must be de-rimmed and cannot contain any debris within the interior or on the exterior such as rocks, oil, dirt or any other foreign matter, otherwise they will be **REJECTED**.
- Only car and light truck tires will be accepted (sizes up to 24”)

“NO COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES OR VENDORS WILL BE ALLOWED”
