TIRE RECYCLING FOR WARREN COUNTY

In an effort to control West Nile Virus and other diseases spread by mosquitos, the Warren County District Landfill, in conjunction with the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders, the Warren County Mosquito Commission and the Warren County Health Department, will begin accepting the following tires from "RESIDENTS, SMALL BUSINESSES, AND FARMING COMMUNITY IN WARREN COUNTY ONLY" at the landfill on a "DAILY BASIS". The landfill is located at 500 Mt. Pisgah Ave, Oxford, NJ. Proof of residency will be required.

<u>TIRES ACCEPTED</u>	<u>FEE</u>
Automobile/SUV sizes with or without rims up to size 22"	\$2.50 each
Commercial sizes with or without rims 22.5" to 24"	\$5.00 each
Farm equipment tires with or without rims 24.5" to 50"	\$10.00 each

PLEASE NOTE:

Tires cannot contain any debris within the interior or on the exterior such as rocks, oil, dirt or any other foreign matter, otherwise they will be REJECTED.

Large loads (in excess of 20 tires) will be REJECTED.
