REQUEST FOR BIDS
2023 FEMA Drainage Repairs
Warren County District Landfill
Oxford, New Jersey

Notice is hereby given that the Pollution Control Financing Authority (PCFA) of Warren County is soliciting bids (hereinafter referred to as "RFB"), in accordance with the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., to address leachate seeps, repair a portion of the gabion downchute on Cell 1E of the Warren County District Landfill, remove sediment from Sedimentation Basin No. 2 located on site, restore a portion of the Sedimentation Basin No. 2 inlet channel, and construct a new inlet for Sedimentation Basin No. 2. The project shall be referred to as 2023 FEMA Drainage Repairs. The bid documents contain a full scope proposal.

Sealed bids for this work will be received by the Director of Operations, Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County, at the PCFA offices located at 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, P.O. Box 587, Oxford, New Jersey 07863-0587, until 11:00 AM prevailing time on April 19, 2023. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the PCFA offices (500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Oxford, New Jersey) at 11:05 AM prevailing time on April 19, 2023.

Late bids will be rejected. The PCFA will not be responsible for delays caused by the United States Postal Service, private courier service, other express or package delivery service, or any other delays affecting delivery of a bid proposal. All information requested in the RFB shall be supplied as a complete bid proposal for evaluation by PCFA.

The work includes, among other things, the removal and replacement of a portion of the final cover and discolored soil, repair of the existing downchute, installation of a new subsurface seep collection trench, cleanout riser, toe drain, sediment removal from Sedimentation Basin No. 2, repair of the existing channel, installation of a new inlet to Sedimentation Basin No. 2, filling of a portion of the existing eroded inlet channel, construction of a maintenance access road, temporary stormwater system, and restoration of the site to existing conditions. All work shall be performed in accordance with the Construction Plans, Technical Specifications, and other Contract Documents.

There will be a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting for prospective bidders on March 22, 2023, at 10:00 AM prevailing time, at the PCFA offices located at 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Oxford, New Jersey. An inspection of the WCDL site will be held in conjunction with the pre-bid meeting.

All questions from bidders regarding the construction shall be submitted to PCFAWC by email at info@pcfawc.com or by fax at (908) 453-4241 by 3:00 PM prevailing time on March 31, 2023. Responses to questions will be distributed to all bidders on April 7, 2023.

The RFB may be examined and obtained at the offices of the PCFA during regular working hours. A \$100.00 non-refundable fee is required, paid by certified check or cash, for each set of paper Contract Documents. Electronic copies of the documents may be obtained at no charge.

Certified checks shall be made payable to Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County. An appointment should be made with Mr. Jonathan Knittel of the PCFA at (908) 453-2174, to facilitate review of pertinent documents. Contract Documents will be available beginning at 11:00 AM prevailing time on March 15, 2023.

A certified check or cashier's check, payable to Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the Bid total, but not to exceed \$20,000, must accompany the bid proposal.


Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq and NJAC 17:27 et. seq; and such other additional requirements as set forth in detail in the RFB.

The Contract will be awarded in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.

The PCFA reserves the right to reject all Bids, or to waive minor irregularities in the Bidding.

Bids may be held by PCFA for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding the Contract. No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within this period.
