<u>**PRESENTATION</u></u> : Director's briefing on Solid Waste Permit Renewal status with NJDEP. Positive draft changes proposed include adding more options for daily cover, using woodchips for truck access within the landfill, and allowing the use of locally available soil for daily cover. Tipping fees will need to be decided for woodchip import from trees, recycled chipped dimension lumber from a recycling facility and for soil import meeting NJDEP testing requirements. A section also streamlines future import of PDM for use on intermediate slopes prior to permanent capping.</u>**

FACILITIES/RECYCLING (Jon Knittel)

- Onsite Waste Water Treatment Plant Evaluation/Upgrade: PCFA and Engineer planning to meet with NJDEP in early August to discuss the permitting process for keeping treated water onsite for reuse for dust control, irrigation, and recharge to groundwater.
- 20 Acre Side Slope Cap Project Update: Barbella continues capping. PCFA continues screening onsite soils to provide material for the project avoiding costly imports and truck traffic. Moderate weather damage occurred to work in progress on July 14th. Import sand was washed down slope and a portion of the eroded sand can be harvested and replaced back on the side slope. Finished portions handled the storm very well.
- A-3 Change Order #7 for approval
 - Odor Update: Regular surface monitoring continues. The 2025 Landfill Gas Expansion Project had a successful bid with three contractors responding. Bid opening was July 2, at 11:05 am. The project includes 6 new vertical gas wells in Cell 7 as well as a large diameter permanent gas collection header for odor control and system expansion.
