PERSONNEL (Jon Knittel)

PCFA has two recent hires to bring our field staff back to 8 equipment operators. Historical personnel levels for prior years were 8 full time operators. Staffing in the field is now a great match to be able to care for the landfill as well as self-perform several preconstruction activities in Cell 6A that will create substantial savings.

FACILITIES/RECYCLING (Jon Knittel)

• Landfill Compactor Replacement: Much progress has been made on replacing our oldest and most important machine at the landfill. Our 25-year-old CAT 826K landfill compactor has been the workhorse of our facility. She is the oldest machine and has the highest hours exceeding 17,500 hours. After several months of investigation into rebuilding this machine as well as looking for alternative replacements in both the used and new market, the PCFA capital committee and the full board (last meeting) has reviewed the various options. The decision was unanimous to move forward with a new TANA H555 eco landfill compactor. Return on investment on this machine works out as the best option when considering multiple variables such as repair costs, dead weight of the machine, better compaction effort comparted to the CAT 836, fuel savings, warranty periods, operator visibility to the front blade and GPS options. Two visits to Salem County Landfill were also performed to watch the machine in action, speak with operators and mechanic and to discuss noticeable and measurable increase in compaction and fuel savings at Salem County Landfill.

- New access road progress slowed with inclement weather, but most tree clearing is complete for the road alignment. Next steps will be to cut the base grade for the road and install a new stormwater catch basin and pipe crossing for the new road.
- Wastewater Treatment Plant Pilot RO study is nearly complete now that lab data has come in. Tetra Tech will present a report of findings once complete.
- Gas Collection Expansion: The 6 new gas wells, a new 16-inch and 12-inch gas header collector pipe have been in service for over one month and functioning as intended. Project is complete.
